Presentation on Faculty Adoption of Textbook & Instructional Materials



Process

Bookstore

- Sends request to faculty via SIS, email, or walk-in.
- If request not received by a certain date, auto-adoption of titles if the section and instructor matches a previous semester to the upcoming semester.

Spring Adoptions Due

OCT. 31

Faculty

- Receives email from Bookstore.
- Submits request to SIS or emails Bookstore directly or walks into Bookstore.

Students

- Searching online for cost of required textbook & materials *before* enrolling.
- Special Programs have limited funds for T & IM. Used as a voucher at the Bookstore.
- Can sell books to bookstore during Finals Week if title is adopted.

Adoptions

Please submit your Spring 2025 textbooks and supplies list by **Monday, November 1, 2024**, so that textbook information for your courses is listed on our website as students sign up for Spring classes. Below are the easy ways to submit your adoptions list. The first two options auto-forward your information to Library Reserves and Disability Resource Department.

If you want your materials list to be automatically re-adopted every Fall semester, please note it on the email. We kindly request that you do not reply to this email as it connects all faculty replies in one very long email chain.
- Submit in-person at the Santa Rosa Bookstore with Patty Asakura or at the Petaluma Bookstore with Bob Eckman.

Textbook Savings Options

- <u>Open Education Resources</u> (OER) provide alternatives to traditional publisher textbooks. <u>Creative Commons</u>enable the delivery of content that otherwise have copyright restrictions. Check out your <u>SRIC Libraries Resource Guides</u> for more information. If you are using an OER material, you still need to submit the information to the Bookstore so that we can post it on our website. We will also work with the Library Reserve to ensure there is a printed version of the material for students to borrow.
- Custom CoursePacks allow faculty to create their own materials instead of using a traditional publisher textbook. You can also use up to 10% of a textbook and combine multiple
 texts into one coursepack. Our publishing partner, <u>LAD Custom Publishing</u>, will negotiate copyright fees with content providers and provide a quote before printing. If you are
 interested in creating your own custom coursepack, let us know via <u>email</u>.
- Have you been using the same title and edition every semester? Let us know! We will automatically auto-adopt your title to your section every semester, and make sure that it is available to rent as an option.

Print books at purchased at full retail value is the most expensive option. Savings are at the end of the semester when students sell books back during Buyback.

Rental books are 40%-60% off purchase price. Savings are upfront and books are due back at the end of the semester.

Digital Ebooks are 40%-70% off purchase price depending on length of access. Length varies from 120 days, 180 days, 365 days, or purchase – depending on publisher's copyright.

Inclusive Access is cheapest option. Student savings is upfront and material is ready on first day of class. Savings up to 85% off full retail value.
